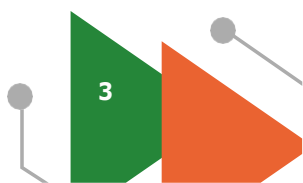

Dear Partners, donors, sponsors, stakeholders, and friends, reflecting on the challenges and achievements of the past year, we find ourselves at the intersection of gratitude and achievements.

In 2023, Regalo Hope Foundation faced unique challenges but emerged triumphant by making significant strides across various sectors and demography. However, we are glad to take this opportunity to share with you, our impact collaborations and plans for the future. Throughout the year, our genuine endeavors have touched the lives of

over 600,000 direct beneficiaries that span women, men, children, youths, and senior citizens.

However, our intervention and impact initiatives include health, education, and technology - hence, covering 20 of the 36 states in Nigeria with high-impact undertakings such as; the RHF learning Hub application, educational conferences, development workshops, training, and capacity-building sessions, mentorship clubs, seminars, vaccination programs, SME/petty traders support and hands-on workshops.

More specifically, we provided comprehensive digital and vocational training sessions to **174,621 youths** conducted in our resource learning center and extending across various states in Nigeria.

In addressing the rising issue of out-of-school children, RHF successfully integrated 73 children into the educational system by providing enduring scholarship opportunities to facilitate and secure the realization of their dreams. In alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals 17 (SDGs), we proudly partnered with and supported **10 non-governmental organizations** - including the Agatha Obiageli Memorial Foundation, Pink Diva Foundation, and Dreams from The Slum Initiative, and many more.

In acknowledging the critical concerns of child mortality and morbidity, and the attendant need for vaccination programs in Nigeria, we conducted a community intervention in Alimosho Local Government Area, Lagos State by educating hundreds of nursing mothers on the importance of infant and childhood vaccination.



Looking ahead into 2024, we are committed to a sustained impact of expanding these human-centered efforts with the support of our donors, sponsors, partners, community stakeholders, friends, and current and previous beneficiaries.

Furthermore, it is worth noting that the RHF Hub Mobile Application, which launched in January 2023 has successfully recorded more than **5,000 Users** - which underscores the venture of triumph into technology-backed educational delivery. As we plan for the future, numerous activities are in the pipeline, some of which require solid, long-term strategic partnerships for the 2024 EduStake Conference and other initiatives.

Let me take this opportunity to extend my deep appreciation to the Board of Trustees, our Advisory Board, our dedicated staff, and volunteers whose tireless efforts have brought us to this momentous moment.

The success of RHF is a collective achievement made possible by the unflinching dedication of our extensive network. To everyone who contributed to our leap and successes in 2023, I express profound gratitude for your invaluable support.

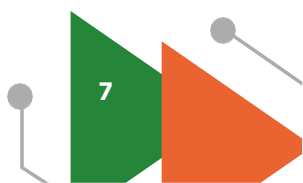

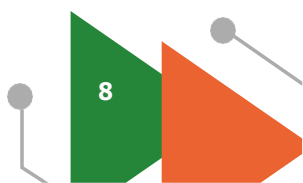

In 2023, RHF deployed an all inclusive approach towards enhancing the standard of education. We:

- extended capacity development to over **1,500** teachers, school owners and managers
- Assembled stakeholders in the public and private space to a solutions roundtable
- Visited over **5** schools to encourage them instil teaching and learning standards, and provide equipment and cash support to the schools.

- Interestingly, the community leadership wrote to RHF for a second visit – RHF is glad to oblige

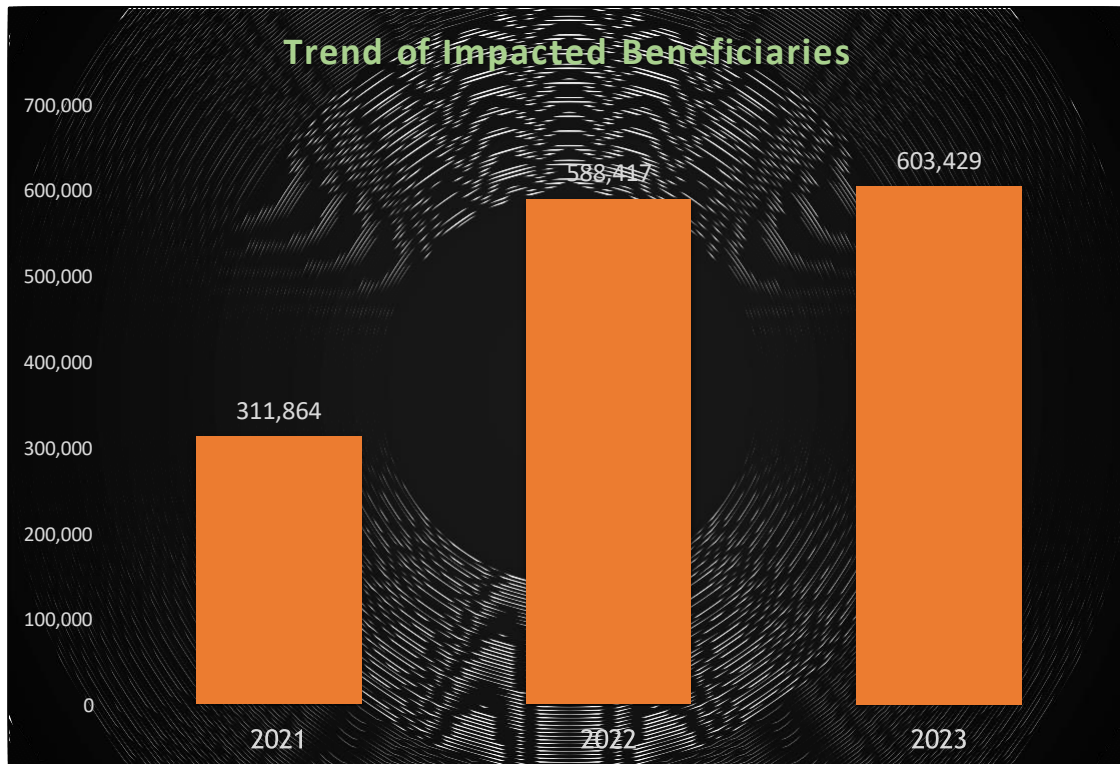

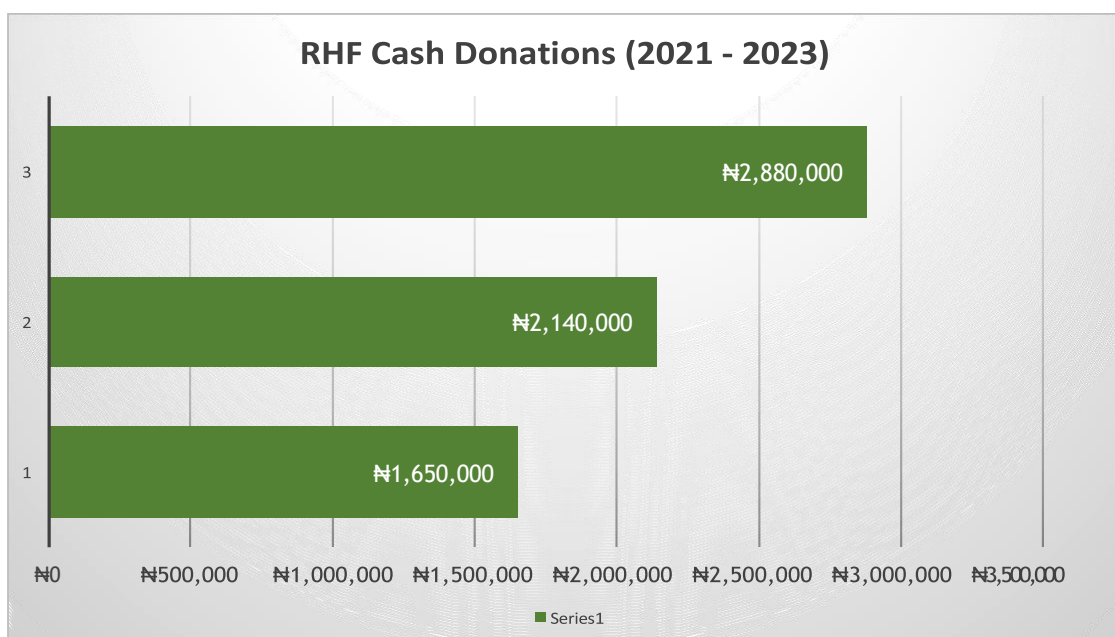
- In a strategic collaboration with Stanbic IBTC Bank, RHF empowered a few residents of Igando Community with Point of Sales (POS) machines.
